What is Youth United?

The Youth United Build 2009 is designed to mobilize young people (aged 5 – 25) and give them an opportunity to raise funds and provide volunteer labor to build a house with a Kansas City family. This project will provide leadership roles for young people and engage them in community development.

What we need to make this project successful

1. Youth/young adults who will work with Habitat to ask for donations, plan events, and recruit other young people to get enough money and in-kind donations to complete the house.
2. Young adults/youth to create an exciting message with good information that will appeal to other young people.
3. Young people who can help keep people excited and motivated once they are involved.
4. Finally, we need youth who will make sure that any activities or events we hold will run smoothly and accomplish the goals we set.

Work Schedule
